CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Specifically permitted

Items that comply with regulations of CPSC and DOT definitions. Permit required for each 5000 individual units of firecrackers.

Specifically prohibited

Aerial fireworks such as, bottle rockets, sky rockets, missile-type rockets, helicopters, torpedoes, daygo bombs, roman candles, flying pigs, and jumping jacks, which move about the ground farther than inside a circle with a radius of twelve feet as measured from the point where the item was placed and ignited, aerial shells and mines.

Age of purchase

18 years

DISPLAY FIREWORKS

Display Permit

Apply to County Fire Department at least 20 days before display date.

Insurance

Proof of liability.

Operator required.

State certificate of fitness license

STORAGE

Approved storage areas per all state and county fire and safety codes.

LICENSING

Annual licenses required, expiring on March 31. Apply to County Fire Department at least 20 days prior to activity. Minimum age 18 years.
