specified).

Specifically prohibited All fireworks that are not defined as salable

consumer fireworks.

Age to purchase 18 years of age

DISPLAY FIREWORKS

Display Permit Apply to State Fire Marshal.

Insurance Required. Minimum \$1,000,000 for personal

injury and death, minimum \$500,000 for property

damages.

Operator State certification required. Pyrotechnics operator

must take written test.
