CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Specifically permitted Items that comply with regulations of CPSC and

DOT definitions. Permit required for each 5,000 individual units of firecrackers.

Specifically prohibited Aerial fireworks such as, bottle rockets, sky

rockets, missile-type rockets, helicopters, torpedoes, daygo bombs, roman candles, flying pigs, and jumping jacks, which move about the ground farther than inside a circle with a radius of twelve feet as measured from the point where the item was placed and ignited, aerial shells and

mines.

Age of purchase 18 years

Age to sell 18 years

Limitations on selling Consumer fireworks cannot be sold after:

12:01 a.m. on New Year's day

6:00 p.m. on Chinese New Year's Day

8:00 p.m. on July 4th.

Limitations on purchasing Purchase of consumer fireworks can only occur

within 5 days of New Years, Chinese New Years, July 4th, or a culture event for which a permit has

been obtained.

DISPLAY FIREWORKS

Display Permit Apply to County at least 20 days before display

date. Permit fee is \$110. An inspection fee of

\$200 may be assessed.

Insurance Surety bond or insurance required. If insurance,

the policy must provide for at least \$5,000 for injury or death of any person, \$10,000 for the injury or death of 2 persons, \$5,000 property damage. If surety bond, minimum amount is \$10,000. Local authority may require higher

amounts.

Operator required State certificate of fitness license

STORAGE Approved storage areas per all state and county

fire and safety codes.

LICENSING Annual licenses required, expiring on March 31.
