Age to purchase

Use restrictions

All consumer fireworks meeting CPSC criteria as defined in APA Std. 87-1 sections 3.1.2, 3.1.3 and 3.5 and ground \& handheld sparkling devices.

Retail location must satisfy NFPA 101, NFPA 1124. Fireworks safety fee imposed on sales. The Dept. of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs' Bureau of Fire Services must review and approve the location.

Certificate to sell retail consumer fireworks required. Fee $\$ 600-\$ 1000$ per location. Expires April 30 the year after issued.

During periods when fireworks are sold, insurance in an amount of \$10,000,000 per occurrence must be held and maintained.

18 years of age. (Also the purchaser cannot be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.)

Cannot be used on public or private property unless express permission is obtained.

Use only permitted as follows:
All day Dec. 31 to 1:00 am on Jan. 1
Sat. \& Sun. before Memorial Day until 11:45pm June 26 - July 4 until 11:45pm July 5 until11:45pm only if that day is Sat. or Sun. Sat. \& Sun. before Labor Day until 11:45pm

## DISPLAY FIREWORKS

Display permit

Insurance

Apply to local governing body. NFPA 1123 applies to the display.

Required; amount determined by local authorities.

Operator

MANUFACTURE, STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION

ENFORCING AUTHORITY

LAW NUMBER

No license specifically required in state law, local authorities may rule on competency and qualifications of operator.

NFPA 1124 storage regulations for consumer fireworks adopted by reference and modified.
