Specifically permitted Consumer fireworks as defined by the CPSC

containing 2 grams or less of explosive composition, including cone fountains, small Chinese crackers, small non-explosive Roman candles, and rockets. Nonexplosive sparklers are

permitted.

Selling period June 15-July 5 and December 5-January 2

Age of purchase 12 years

DISPLAY FIREWORKS

Display permit Apply to local authorities at least 15 days before

display date. Provisions of NFPA 1123 must be

met. (NFPA 1126 for an indoor display.)

Insurance Required.

Operator No license specifically required in state law.

MANUFACTURE, STORAGE, Safe storage areas and safe disposal specified in

TRANSPORTATION the law, but must be a competent operator,

approved by the fire official

LICENSING State and local licenses are required to

manufacture fireworks; apply to state tax

commission and local authorities.
